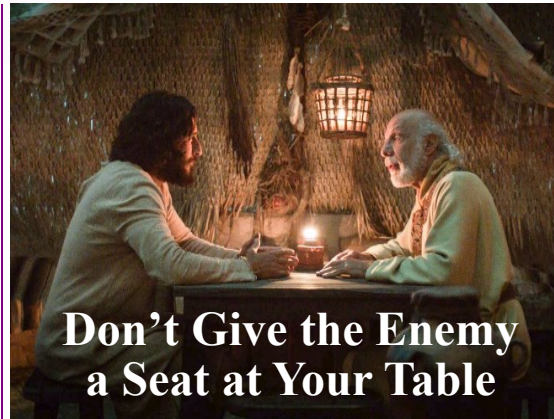
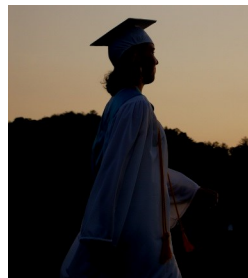


Grad Dinner Sunday Night

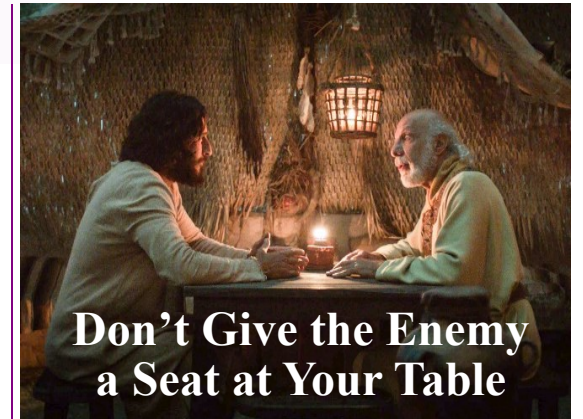
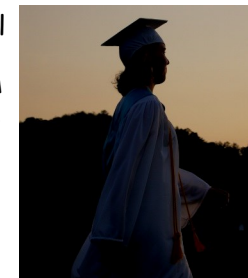


Grad Dinner Sunday Night

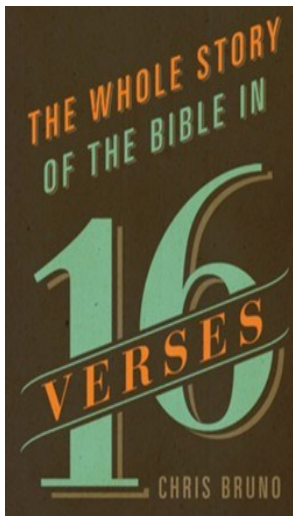

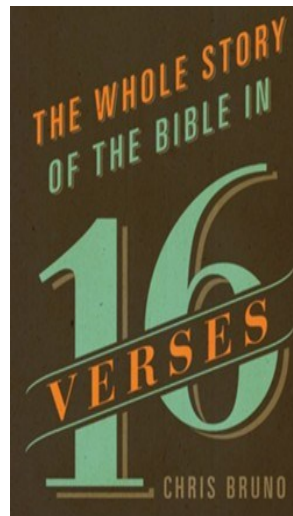
